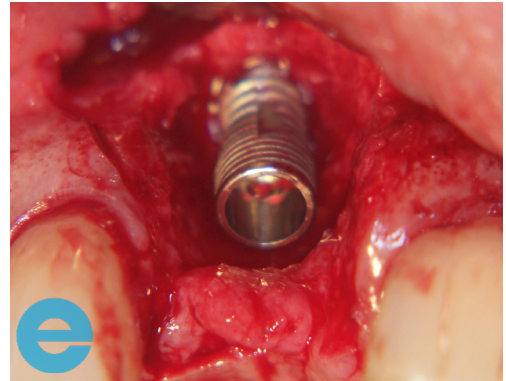


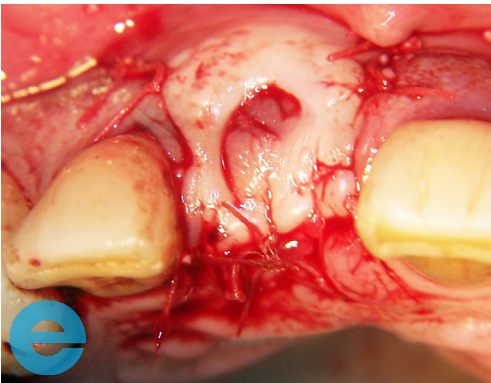
LONG TERM BUCCAL GRAFT



1. 4 weeks post extraction, loss of profile



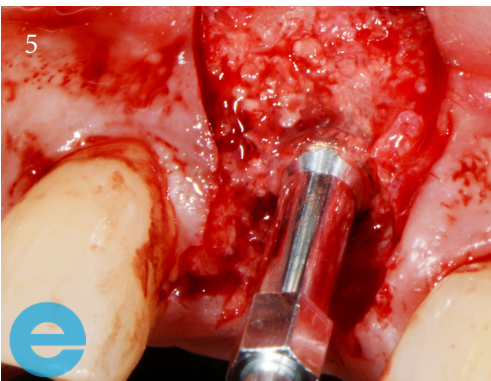
2. Placement of implant, site specific flap



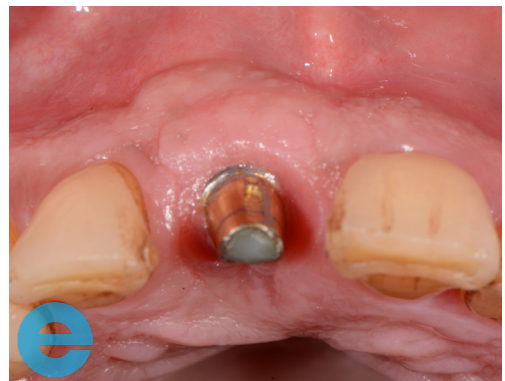
3. Sutured closed after grafting with EthOss®



4. Flap raised at 12 weeks to show new host bone (very little remnant graft)



5. Osstell reading 76 ISQ

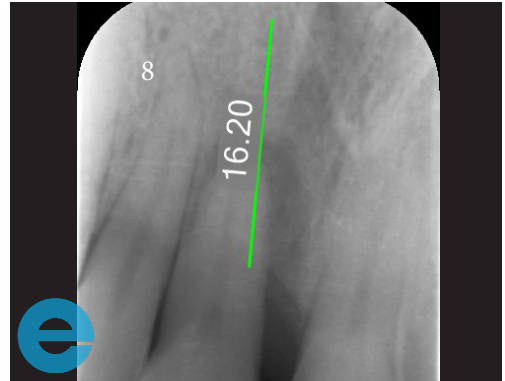


6. Re-cemented at 4 years loaded, showing retained profile

7. Good longer term profile retention



8. Tooth to be extracted with bone loss



9. Pilot measurement



10. Radiograph showing implant placed into 2mm host bone and EthOss® graft



11. Implant ready to load at 7 weeks



12. Radiograph at 4 years showing stable bone
